

## Master's Program Resident Scholarship

Beginning in Fall 2021, the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering will be offering a per credit hour scholarship for eligible students.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- Must be a Wisconsin resident OR eligible for tuition reciprocity (e.g. Minnesota resident)
- Must be enrolled in one of the Department's two named options programs:
  - Industrial Engineering: Systems Engineering & Analytics, M.S.
  - Industrial Engineering: Human Factors and Health Systems Engineering, M.S.
- Available only to students who do not have an appointment whereby they receive tuition remission

## **Credit Amounts**

- · Wisconsin residents: \$500/credit
- Tuition reciprocity students: \$300/credit

## **Additional Information**

- Students who meet the above criteria are automatically eligible for this scholarship. No formal application by the student is necessary.
- This scholarship is independent of the bursar's office. As such, students will be required to make tuition payments as normally scheduled at the start of the semester, and will receive an award from the department independent of those payments.
- Scholarship award will be available after the semester's last deadline to drop classes.
- After the last date for dropping classes, scholarship will be awarded from the department directly into the student's bursar office account.
- Award will be made prior to the registration deadline for the next term.
